EPISTLE READING – Ephesians 2:1-10 And you were dead in the trespasses and sins ² in which you once walked, following the course of this world, following the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that is now at work in the sons of disobedience-- ³ among whom we all once lived in the passions of our flesh, carrying out the desires of the body and the mind, and were by nature children of wrath, like the rest of mankind. ⁴ But God, being rich in mercy, because of the great love with which he loved us, ⁵ even when we were dead in our trespasses, made us alive together with Christ-- by grace you have been saved-- ⁶ and raised us up with him and seated us with him in the

heavenly places in Christ Jesus, ⁷ so that in the coming ages he might show the immeasurable riches of his grace in kindness toward us in Christ Jesus. ⁸ For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, ⁹ not a result of works, so that no one may boast. ¹⁰ For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them.

GOSPEL READING – John 3:14-21 And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, so must the Son of Man be lifted up, ¹⁵ that whoever believes in him may have eternal life. ¹⁶ "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life. ¹⁷ For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but in order that the world might be saved through him. ¹⁸ Whoever believes in him is not condemned, but whoever does not believe is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the only Son of God. ¹⁹ And this is the judgment: the light has come into the world, and people loved the darkness rather than the light because their works were evil. ²⁰ For everyone who does wicked things hates the light and does not come to the light, lest his works should be exposed. ²¹ But whoever does what is true comes to the light, so that it may be clearly seen that his works have been carried out in God."

SERMON – Numbers 21:4-9 From Mount Hor they set out by the way to the Red Sea, to go around the land of Edom. And the people became impatient on the way. ⁵ And the people spoke against God and against Moses, "Why have you brought us up out of Egypt to die in the wilderness? For there is no food and no water, and we loathe this worthless food." ⁶ Then the LORD sent fiery serpents among the people, and they bit the people, so that many people of Israel died. ⁷ And the people came to Moses and said, "We have sinned, for we have spoken against the LORD and against you. Pray to the LORD, that he take away the serpents from us." Letter from Australia *The following is a letter (and wonderful, faithful Christian witness) written to the CLC from the Stillers, a family/congregation of 5 in Dutton, Australia. The Stillers are members of the CLC.*

“We are happy to give the brethren information of our congregation, but there is not really a lot we can present.

“We are totally on our own, as in the Barossa Valley and its greater area, there is so much baked-on blind loyalty to the heterodox LCA (Lutheran Church of Australia). Even those (and there are a few) who KNOW the rottenness in the LCA are so stubborn and cowardly to do anything about it as they are commanded (Romans 16:17). We are in fact hated and mocked, as in a community that all sticks together, gossip and slander have prime opportunity and flourishes. Nevertheless, our sufficiency is of Christ, and we with God’s strength hold our heads up and continue in knowing what is right and God-pleasing.

“We hold our divine services each Sunday, celebrating the Lord’s Supper fortnightly. We use the traditional order of service for the Communion and non-Communion Services which was standard in the time of my childhood days. This was also the English order that my father knew so well. It was so beneficial for dad, especially in later times, when he was not able to read from the printed order. We cherish this sound and Christ/Redeemer focused order, and there is no problem (except of our own human laziness) in benefitting from the heavenly and devotional content. When you have got something good—stick to it. . . .

“I was privileged to be able instruct and confirm our children, Rebekah, Jesse and Mariah. To date I have conducted 2 funeral services.

“We have our family devotions each day and delight in each evening after devotion, singing with the organ three hymns to lift our hearts to God in prayer and praise.

“As I need to be employed in secular work, I am so grateful that God has given me this spiritual service of His to our precious Christ-bought brothers and sisters here in an apostate land. To God be the Glory. Amen!”
